

The first Organizational Forum of the WORLD ACROBATICS SOCIETY was held at the Melrose Suites Hotel in Las Vegas, Nevada on March 11, 12, 13 of this year. Twenty-five of the nations most eminent individuals in Gymnastics, Diving, Sports Acrobatics, Trampoline & Tumbling, Free-Style Skiing and Professional Acrobatics participated in this venture. This organization, called W.A.S. was officially formed, a Board of Directors and an Executive Director were elected, plans for the future were formulated and a basic "Mission Statement" evolved. The mission statement is as follows:



# A BRIEF HISTORY of THE WORLD ACROBATICS SOCIETY



On February 3, 1994, a surprise 80th birthday party was held at the Treasure Island Hotel in Las Vegas, Nevada for George Nissen. Nissen is recognized the world over as one of the original pioneers in the sport of trampolining and one of the world's leading manufacturers of quality gymnastics equipment. No less than 115 guests appeared to help George celebrate his birthday and the guest list included some of the world's best known figures in all areas of acrobatics.

After the celebration, Bob Bollinger, the Master of Ceremonies for the occasion, received a considerable amount of input concerning the possible formation of some type of social organization that would bring people of similar interests in acrobatics together on a regular basis. For over two years, Bollinger and others, continued to receive positive input concerning this idea.

In October of 1995, Bollinger called a meeting at the home of his son, Rob Bollinger in Las Vegas, Nevada. Attending that meeting were Dr. Joseph Schabacker (Life-Time Honorary President of the United States Sports Acrobatics Federation) and one of its founders, Charlie Pond, world renowned tumbling, free-style skiing and gymnastics coach, Glenn Sundby, past editor of many gymnastics and acrobatic magazines, Dr. Glenn Wilson, former National Trampoline Champion, Don (Otto) Zazadaney, professional acrobat and Rob Bollinger, Professional Acrobatic performer with the "Cirque du Soleil".

At this meeting, plans for an Organizational Forum for the establishment of a World Acrobatics Organization were developed and it was decided to hold such a Forum in Las Vegas on March 11, 12 and 13th of 1996. Over 100 invitations were sent out and over 75% responded positively to the establishment of such an organization. Many of these positive respondents were unable to attend the March Forum but they assured us of their support. A total of 25 people (from six of the seven acrobatic disciplines), attended the Forum and officially established the WORLD ACROBATICS SOCIETY.

### **OUR MEMBERSHIP POLICY**







## THE INCOMPARABLE LARRY GRISWOLD

If ever there was a "Living Legend" in the field of professional acrobatics, it had to be LARRY GRISWOLD of Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Beginning his professional career in 1929 with the "Billy Rose Aquacade", he was one of the featured comedy divers at the Ukranian Village during the Century of Progress World's Fair in Chicago in 1933-34. Shortly after, Larry coached gymnastics at the University of Iowa where he met George Nissen. Together, they developed the concept of the modern Trampoline for both recreational and sporting use. While George kept busy manufacturing trampolines, Larry went on the show-biz circuit with his Trampoline and Diving board act. He performed on the Ed Sullivan Show many times and was featured at the Follies Bergere in Paris, France during the late 1960s. Loved by all and missed by many......Larry, at age 90, is in a nursing home in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.







The above photo of George Nissen (taken in the 1950s), is perhaps, the most widely publicized -trampoline picture of all time. Picked up by newspapers everywhere, the photo was seen world wide.

Actually, it was a publicity stunt for a New York department store. George rented a kangaroo for the big event. We all know just how much George enjoyed the occasion. We are still not too sure how the kangaroo liked the deal!



In the mid 1950s, George Nissen, Frank LaDue and Swiss gymnast, Kurt Bachler introduced the trampoline to the Europeans. Pictured above (left-right) are Frank, Kurt and George performing at the Gymnastrada. For many years thereafter, the U.S.A. dominated World trampoline competition. Today, the Europpeans rule the roost!




